Salem County authorities investigating suspicious death of 73-year-old Woodstown woman

MANNINGTON TWP. — A Woodstown woman has been pronounced dead here from blunt head trauma, said Salem County Prosecutor John Lenahan.

Carol A. Brown, 73 of Hilcrest Drive in Woodstown, was said by authorities to have been transported to the Memorial Hospital of Salem County arriving at 11:15 p.m. Wednesday night.

Lenahan said attending physicians at the hospital pronounced Brown dead at 11:25 p.m.

Her injuries area said to be blunt trauma to the head and could be suspicious in nature.

An autopsy is being conduct and the investigation is ongoing.
